### **WHEREAS**

  - 2.4 Identifying opportunities for conducting lectures and seminars and organising symposia and conferences
  - 2.5 Exchanges of academic information and materials
  - 2.6 Promoting collaboration in fields of mutual interest
  - 2.7 Promoting other academic co-operation and collaboration as mutually agreed.
- 3. The development and implementation of specific activities developed under this MOU will be the subject of formal written agreements negotiated and entered into separately, which will deal with the financial arrangements, confidentiality, ownership and use of intellectual property, publication of articles or other work and other relevant matters.
- 4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in Clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Parties concerned.
- 5. Parties acknowledge the need to promote the programme and activities pursuant to this MOU and hereby agree to use promotional materials that have been approved by the other Party.

- Both Parties agree that staff and students of either institution engaged in activities under this MOU shall carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of their respective countries after full consultation and approval.
- This MOU may only be amended by a written agreement signed by a duly authorised representative of each Party.
- 8. This MOU shall commence of the date of its execution by the last Party to sign and shall remain in force for a period of five years. Each Party shall review the status of the MOU at least six months before the end of the five-year period to determine whether it wishes the MOU to continue and, if so, whether any modifications are required. The period of validity of this MOU may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both Parties.
- Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving six months' notice in writing to the other. The termination of this MOU shall not affect the implementation of any specific activities established under it prior to such termination.
